The NHS Adviser is appointed by the Secondary Principal. NHS holds monthly meetings, sponsors Operation Christmas Child, helps the school library with the annual Used Book Fair, holds two fundraisers for the CCS NHS senior scholarship, sponsors other service projects as opportunities or needs arise, and holds an annual NHS Induction and Officer Installation Banquet.
