

Student Conduct Agreement

(For Students Entering Grades 7-12)

The biblical and philosophical goal of Covenant Christian School is to develop students into mature individuals who will be able to exhibit a Christlike life in the community. Of necessity, this involves the school's understanding and belief of what qualities or characteristics exemplify a Christlike life. While enrolled at Covenant Christian School, all students are expected to exhibit the qualities of a Christlike life espoused and taught by the school and to refrain from certain activities or behavior. (Leviticus 20:13; Romans 1:27)

Covenant Christian School's student body should consist of students who are individually committed to fulfilling Colossians 3:17: "...whatever you do, in work or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus..."

I give my full support of the stated aims and policies of Covenant Christian School. I will make every reasonable effort to comply with the following:

- As a student enrolled at CCS, I will seek to be diligent in upholding the standards of the school for myself and encourage my fellow students to do the same.
- I pledge to cooperate with and show respect for all authority placed over me, and I understand that defiant behavior is grounds for disciplinary action. (Romans 13:1-2; Hebrews 13:17)
- I understand that attending CCS is a privilege, and that my personal behavior and dress are to be a testimony to the Lord in all aspects of my life.
- I understand that I am to uphold the standards of CCS both on and off campus and that a violation of our standards could result in disciplinary action.
- I understand that CCS retains the right to refuse enrollment to, or for an admitted student, to require counseling, or in certain circumstances, disciplinary action up to and including suspension or expulsion, any students who engage in sexual immorality, including any student who professes to be homosexual, bisexual or transgender or is a practicing homosexual, bisexual or transgender. (I Corinthians 6:9-20)

- I understand that the on or off campus use of non-approved/illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages, or any form of tobacco will result in disciplinary action, including possible suspension or expulsion. (I Corinthians 6:9-15)
- I understand that the use of profane language, the reading, viewing, or possession of pornographic materials, and Biblically immoral behavior are against CCS standards, detrimental to a Christian witness, and could result in disciplinary action, including suspension or expulsion. (Proverbs 6:27-28; Romans 12:2, Job 31:1; Psalms 119:37)
- I understand that inappropriate use of technology (which includes social networking, email, text messaging, etc.) could result in disciplinary action including suspension or expulsion. This includes but is not limited to disrespectful comments, using inappropriate language, posting inappropriate pictures, and sending inappropriate or threatening messages. (Proverbs 16:24; I Timothy 4:12; I Thessalonians 5:11; James 3:3-12)
- I understand I may be suspended or expelled for academic dishonesty. (Exodus 20:15; Matthew 19:18)
- I realize that failure to support CCS as stated above may result in my involuntary dismissal.

Student and parent/guardian signatures will be required on this document to apply, enroll, and re-enroll annually at Covenant Christian School.
