

Tuition Assistance

In partnership with generous donors, CCS operates a need-based assistance program for enrolled families. Tuition assistance decisions are based on the availability of school resources and the amount of verified tuition assistance needs each school year.

CCS utilizes FACTS Grant & Aid (FG&A) to streamline the financial aid assessment process. Families submit an application and supporting documents such as tax returns and W-2 through a secure portal, and FG&A makes recommendations to CCS based on data collected. In addition to FG&A's recommendations, each family's financial and personal situation is considered. Please know that we have the utmost respect for your privacy, and all information is held in strict confidence.

Tuition assistance may be awarded annually to assist with the payment of tuition. Tuition assistance is only on tuition and does not cover application/enrollment fees, student fees or other optional or required fees. Once awarded, the student(s) and parent(s) must remain in good financial, conduct and academic standing with the school as a condition of assistance being continued.

What is needed?

- Complete FACTS Grant and Aid application <https://goo.gl/6qD0K1> (Use your FACTS Tuition Login and go to the right side of screen and click on START APPLICATION)
- Send tax documents to FACTS to verify your application

Priority is given to current families.

Current Families dates to be considered for Tuition Assistance:

- April 16 Deadline for application and tax documents uploaded to FACTS
- April 30 Review of completed and verified applications begin
- May 7 Notify recipients of decision by committee

New Families dates to be considered for Tuition Assistance:

- May 18 Deadline for application and tax documents uploaded to FACTS
- May 28 Review of completed and verified applications begin
- June 4 Notify recipients of decision by committee
