

CLASS TRIP TO CAROLINA CREEK

As an enrichment experience, each year a class trip is planned for the secondary students at Covenant Christian School. This year the trip for high school students in grades 11 and 12 will be to Carolina Creek Christian Camp in Huntsville. **The trip is scheduled for October 6-8.** The major purpose is to provide an opportunity for these students to gain insight into the challenges that await them after they graduate and leave CCS. Students will learn valuable information, skills, and strategies to help them defend their faith on a college campus and in the “real world”.

Students should plan to bring the following items:

- Bible
- Pen, paper
- Towels, washcloths
- Soap, toothbrush and toothpaste
- Pillow & sheets or sleeping bag
- Routine medications (prescriptions, antihistamines, etc.) – which must be given to a chaperone
- Insect repellent
- Flashlight
- 3 t-shirts (of good quality, proper size, and only Christian logos or slogans)
- Shorts and/or jeans – modest and size appropriate
- Light jacket or sweatshirt
- Athletic shoes appropriate for participating in physical activities
- An expectant attitude of what the Lord is going to do during this trip
- *Students should plan NOT to bring any electronic devices such as cell phones, iPods, Gameboys, etc.*
