

# **CLASS TRIP TO FRONTIER CAMP**

Dear Parents,

As an enrichment experience, each year a class trip is planned for the students in grades 7 and 8. This year the trip is scheduled for **October 6-8. Frontier Camp** is located about 12 miles north of Crockett, Texas, near the town of Grapeland. In case of emergency, their phone number is 936.544.3206.

Frontier Camp offers excellence in Christian camping. It is located on 75 acres of east Texas forestland and features a prime stretch of waterfront on a secluded cove of Houston County Lake.

Mrs. Mayes, Mrs. Severson and Mrs. Allen will chaperone the girls, while Mr. Allen and Dan Miller will chaperone the boys. The chaperones will be transporting the students in vans to and from camp.

Students should plan to bring the following items:

- Pillow and sheets or sleeping bag
- Towels and washcloths
- Toothbrush, toothpaste and grooming items
- Routine medications (prescriptions, antihistamines, etc.) – These must be given with specific instructions to one of the chaperones.
- Flashlight
- Insect repellent
- Bible
- A light jacket or sweatshirt
- One-piece swimsuit (two-piece is permitted with a shirt to wear over it)
- Shorts and blue jeans (shorts must be modest and appropriate)
- Athletic shoes appropriate for participating in physical activities
- An expectant attitude of what the Lord is going to do during this trip
- *Students should plan NOT to bring any electronic devices such as cell phones, iPods, Gameboys, etc.*

Each student will also need to bring money for souvenirs, snacks, etc. We will leave CCS on October 6 at 2:00 and return by 3:15 on October 8.
